

Also includes pre-touring, 2 nights of accommodation in Buenos Aires and all meals.

Flights: Arrival and departure airfare to and from Buenos Aires is not included. Chartered flight to/from the vessel in Ushuaia are included in the package.

Single Occupancy Notice: Due to limited Antarctica capacities, single occupancy cabins are by request only. All cabins are request only until confirmed by our partners at Hurtigruten.

6-16 ADVENTURES ON ANTARCTICA

Nothing quite prepares you for it! Surrounded by looming glaciers, and icebergs the size of floating cathedrals, Antarctica will fill you with wonder. Perhaps the most surprising part of Antarctica is the silence and remote nature. The stillness can only be broken by the locals - the wildlife!

Huge colonies of penguins huddle on the ice flows, avoiding the cunning leopard seals that hunt them. Majestic, migrating whales glide among amazing icebergs, hunting the shoals of krill they feed on. Here, nature is king and guests are observers.

Over the next 10 days, the experienced captain will continually monitor conditions to create the best possible itinerary for your adventure, with no two being the same. Spend an exciting 11 days busily exploring several of the many possible landing sites. Each day offers something different and thrilling. 17-18 SAILING THROUGH DRAKE PASSAGE




19 RETURN TO BUENOS AIRES

CABIN KEY

- RR Cabins

RR - OUTSIDE CABIN

Primarily located on the middle decks. Most are 215 square feet, with windows and flexible sleeping arrangements, as well as a TV and a bathroom and shower.



XT - ARCTIC SUPERIOR WITH BALCONY

Arctic Superior cabins are comfortable and roomy with a balcony. Flexible sleeping arrangements and a sofa bed, as well as a TV and a bathroom and shower.



ME - SUITE WITH BALCONY

These suites are large, well-appointed cabins with expansive windows and most have balconies. The suites feature flexible sleeping arrangements with comfortable seating areas and TV. Many can accommodate up to four people. Expedition suites are exclusively in upper and mid-deck locations.

Experienced Guides and Expedition Leaders - At Your Service

All packages are fully-guided by individuals who understand and are experts in the field, history and ecological regions visited. These individuals are selected to act with extensive knowledge which will share information during lectures including glaciology, marine biology, and history. These same guides will travel with you during landings, hikes and boat cruising. All tours also include a John Hall's Alaska representative to ensure all John Hall's Alaska standards are met throughout the program.

Wildlife in Antarctica

Penguins aren't the only animals you will see in Antarctica. John Hall's Alaska has handpicked January due to the weather, animal migration patterns including whale watching, bird spotting and viewing seals - be prepared for a variety of animals only found in Antarctica.

Activities in Antarctica

John Hall's Alaska has partnered with the Hurtigruten Expeditions team to provide the most rich, hands on experience through the Antarctic region. While in Argentina and on-board the MS Roald Amundsen, guests experience a full program and optional activities, taking in the best Antarctica has to offer, all while exploring as a JHA World Adventure group. Whatever your activity or mobility level, the John Hall's Alaska team will find something that suits each guests' comfort level.

Dining Style

All meals are included while traveling with John Hall's Alaska World Adventures to Antarctica. This includes pre-cruise and while onboard the vessel. A variety of options will be available based on expedition time, travel time and daily plans.

Beverages

Complimentary beverages will be provided at breakfast, lunch and dinner and will include coffee, iced tea, lemonade and soft drinks. Beer and house wines are included with lunch and dinner. Upgraded beverages are also available by request including premium spirits, wine and beer.

Electricity Onboard

The plugs in cabins are all 200V/50hz. The plugs are continental two-pin plugs, which may require an adaptor.

Baggage Handling, Tax and Gratuities

Don't lift a finger! We take care of all luggage, delivering it to the guests room and stateroom. All entrance fees, hotel charges, taxes, fees and resort fees are included. In addition, gratuities for activities, meals, baggage handling, local guides, expedition team members and drivers are also included.

**Gratuity for your John Hall's Alaska representative is not included with your package and is at your discretion. We recommend \$5-7 per person, per day.



IMPORTANT DETAILS

How to Book

To confirm your reservation, a deposit of **\$3500.00 USD per person** is due within 10 days of reservation. To reserve your space, please contact our office at 800.325.2270. Guests may also book online by visiting our World Adventure page at www.KissAlaska.com. Deposits are accepted by check or credit card including Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express.

****A discount of \$300 USD per person will be extended for those paying their tour balance by cash or check. Deposit may still be made by credit card, however will be subject to a 4% fee if cancelled outside 180 days.**

Final Payment

Final payment is due 180 days prior to departure date. If payment is not received in time, space may be released. Additional monies are not due between deposit and final payment. Guests will be charged a \$35 USD per check that is submitted with insufficient funds.

Tour Cancellation

If a cancellation is made in writing at least 180 days in advance of departure, a full refund will be made, less a 4% fee on any monies paid by credit card.

For cancellations inside 180 days, the following penalties will be incurred:

90-180 Days - 50% of paid fare

61-89 Days - 75% of paid fare

Inside 60 days - 100% of paid fare

****Cancellation penalties and deposit policies follow all Hurtigruten requirements, policies and penalties.**

Trip Insurance

John Hall's Alaska partners with Travel Insured to supply guests with trip insurance. Guests should purchase this prior to making final payment. Details and pricing will be included with initial invoices, final payment reminders and can be found by visiting www.KissAlaska.com. We highly recommend travel insurance for all guests.

****If you intend to take out trip insurance to cancel for any reason, this must be done immediately upon securing your reservation.**

Suggested Packing

The dress code is 100% casual while traveling in Antarctica and onboard the MS Roald Amundsen. You can expect temperatures to range from 0-50 degrees depending on the locations, activities and elevation. Clothing that can be easily layered is best to pack. MS Roald Amundsen will provide towels, bathroom amenities and other personal items for your use while onboard. Bottled water will also be available while onboard.

Our recommendation to pack includes, but not limited to: warm winter jacket, wind and water resistance thermal underwear, warm hat, gloves/mittens, scarf, warm socks, sunglasses with UV lenses, good shoes for walking on shore, swimsuit for hot tub, infinity pool or sauna.

John Hall's Alaska will provide a sub zero multi-climate winter jacket. Hurtigruten will provide guests with complimentary rubber boots, as they are required by environmental regulations. Please provide sizes for both at the time of securing reservations.

Guests may choose to bring their own rubber boots or walking sticks, however will be required to be checked by expedition team prior to use and wash/disinfected pre/post each use.

Dietary Restrictions

Salt free, kosher, food allergies, gluten free or any other special dietary meals must be requested in advance. Please advise this at the time of booking.

****Please make our reservation team aware of any other accommodations we can assist with during the booking process.**

Luggage Handling

All gratuities for luggage handling are included with your John Hall's Alaska package. One piece of luggage per guest will be delivered to your room and stateroom. Local airline requirements allow one suitcase under 50 pounds. Carry-on luggage should be manageable and fit in the overhead of storage compartments on airplanes and motorcoaches, keeping in mind several of these are smaller versus your traditional airline overheads. Carry on luggage should not exceed 21 inches for its largest dimension.

Cell Phones and Wi-Fi

Wireless internet is available however may be limited during remote locations or when satellite connections are limited. Cell phones may also be required to be turned to airplane mode when in Antarctica's National Parks, however Expedition Guides will advise when this is required.
