
WHY CONSIDER SOUTHERN AFRICA FOR YOUR NEXT ADVENTURE?

1 CAPE TOWN

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, guests will be met by a John Hall's Alaska representative and transferred to the first evening accommodations located at Victoria and Alfred Harbor, The Table Bay Hotel. Enjoy exclusive access to Long Lee Manor, one of 7 boutique lodges on Shamwari Private Game Reserve. Settle in with a welcome lunch before meeting your expert guides for the next 3 days.

There is so much to see and do before guests head out. Game viewing drives will be available each morning and evening, as this is when the wildlife is most active. Survey the areas, witnessing birds while looking for the "Big Five" from the comfort and safety of the open game viewing vehicles. Professional rangers and guides share their passion for the wildlife and their knowledge in their respective level of expertise.

Visit the Born Free Big Cat Rescue and education center aimed to draw attention to the plight of wild cats, confined in a variety of environments throughout the world. Also visit Shamwari Wildlife Rehabilitation Center, which helps to rescue, rehabilitate and care for the sick, injured, abandoned or orphaned animals.

Following your time at Shamwari Private Game Reserve, expect to take away a new appreciation for Africa's wildlife and unforgettable experiences.

VICTORIA FALLS

Early this morning, say goodbye to the beautiful reserve while heading for Port Elizabeth Airport. Guests fly to Victoria Falls, via Johannesburg, landing in Zimbabwe early afternoon. Upon arrival, transfer to the historical and elegant Victoria Falls Hotel for the remainder of the afternoon and evening at the guests' leisure.

VICTORIA FALLS

This morning depart on your walking tour of Victoria Falls - a path along the edge of the forest provides the visitor who is prepared to brave the tremendous spray with an unparalleled series of views of the falls. Return to the hotel to relax on the terrace and enjoy lunch. Depart in the late afternoon for your Bushtracks Express vintage train dinner. The train will stop on the Victoria Falls bridge and gives visitors the chance to disembark, look around and capture iconic pictures with Victoria Falls in the background. Enjoy dinner before returning to the Victoria Falls Station platform and return to the Victoria Falls Hotel for one more evening.

BOTSWANA & ZAMBEZI QUEEN

Travel by bus to the Botswana border before being met by the Zambezi Queen team. Following Botswana departure immigrations, proceed to Namibian customs continuing onto the chartered vessel and your home for three evenings, the Zambezi Queen by Mantis, a luxurious and exclusive riverboat. Relax onboard while familiarizing yourself with the vessel enjoying welcome drinks, dinner and beverages before retiring to plush accommodations on the Zambezi River.



Expert Drivers and Guides

All packages are fully-guided by individuals who understand and are experts in the field, history and regions visited. Each country is extremely different, let alone each city, island or region. While in the Southern Africa region, John Hall's Alaska will pair with expert drivers and guides in each location. All individuals have extensive knowledge and will share information during the World Adventure. All tours also include a John Hall's Alaska representative to ensure all John Hall's Alaska standards are met throughout the program.

Dining Style

All meals are included while traveling with John Hall's Alaska World Adventures to South Africa, Zimbabwe, Botswana and Namibia. When possible, programs support locally sourced businesses with the ability to provide the most authentic experience. This includes a variety of local fruits, vegetables, fish, and other proteins unique to the countries. A variety of options will be available for guests during their dining experiences. Please let us know at the time of booking if there are any food allergies or intolerances.

Beverages

Complimentary beverages will be provided at breakfast, lunch and dinner including unlimited water, coffee, iced tea, soft drinks and lemonade. During dinner meal service, a choice of alcoholic beverage will also be offered. A variety of alcoholic beverages are included and offered while visiting Shamwari Private Game Reserve and onboard the Zambezi Queen. Premium beverages, bottles of wine or other high end alcoholic drinks may be an additional charge.

Wireless Internet and Electricity While Traveling

All included hotels provide free wireless internet, although some only provide access in the hotel lobby.

Power outlets for use during the Southern African Adventure includes an electrical supply of 220/230 volts AAC50 HZ. Plugs can be found in either 2 or 3 prongs and will vary by property. Please make sure adaptors and converters match this type of plug. We recommend verifying if personal electronic devices have built in converters.

Baggage Handling, Tax and Gratuities

Don't lift a finger! We take care of all luggage, delivering it to the guests' room each evening and picking it up for departure. All entrance fees, hotel charges, taxes, fees and resort fees are included. In addition, gratuities for activities, meals, baggage handling, local guides and drivers are also included.

**Gratuity for your John Hall's Alaska representative is not included with your package and is at your discretion. We recommend \$7-10 per person, per day, for the entire duration of the trip.

Cell Phone Usage

Cell phone reception and availability will vary depending on carrier. Please check with your carrier on international cell phone opportunities. John Hall's Alaska recommends guests have minimal international service in the event of an emergency or departure from tour. Many carriers will offer basic cell phone plans which are only charged for days cell phone is used.

Checked Luggage

During the Southern African Adventure, guests will be limited to one suitcase per person weighing under 44 pounds. This is a requirement of the regional carriers serving air travel between South Africa and Botswana.

Carry on Luggage

Carry on luggage size is also restricted to 35 linear inches total (length + width + height). Several TSA approved rollaboard carryon's are too large. We recommend the largest dimension being 18" which should include most backpacks, purses or medical devices.

WHAT TO WEAR

The dress code is 100% casual. Comfortable walking shoes are a must (closed-toed shoes with good traction) for days spent touring. Please remember to pack beach wear including swimsuits, sunscreen, sunglasses, bug spray and sandals. Consider bringing a small pair of lightweight binoculars. Evening attire is smart casual yet comfortable so plan for golf polos, dresses and other easy to pack items. Almost all properties have send out laundry service to ensure laundry is available throughout your experience. To pack light, we highly recommend travelers take advantage of this service.

It is recommended to avoid wearing black and navy blue while on safari experiences. Navy blue attracts the tsetse flies so recommend avoid wearing navy blue at all times, even while in Cape Town. Black can be worn on travel days, during Cape Town experiences or during time at lodges. Lightweight and quick dry material is an essential for travel. Due to the color of the soil, we recommend avoiding white clothing at all times.

During safari, lightweight yet multi layers are recommended. Light colored khaki, blue, green, grey and tan are the best apparel color choices. Avoid white due to the stains from dirt on game drives. We highly recommend avoiding camouflage and other regalia as this often resembles military and is illegal in some areas of travel. It is also important to remember most safari game drives include speeds in open vehicles of 35-50 miles per hour. This can significantly impact guest warmth and comfort.

GROUP FLIGHTS

All flights for traveling within South Africa and Botswana are included as part of the package.



IMPORTANT DETAILS

How to Book

To confirm your reservation, a deposit of \$3500.00 USD per person is due within 10 days of reservation. To reserve your space, please contact our office at 800.325.2270. Guests may also book online by visiting our World Adventure page at www.KissAlaska.com. Deposits are accepted by check or credit card including Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express.

**A discount of \$300 USD per person will be extended for those paying their tour balance by cash or check. Deposit may still be may by credit card, however will be subject to a 4% fee if cancelled outside 120 days.

Final Payment

Final payment is due 120 days prior to departure date. If payment is not received in time, space may be released. Additional monies are not due between deposit and final payment. Guests will be charged a \$35 USD per check that is submitted with insufficient funds.

Tour Cancellation

If a cancellation is made in writing at least 120 days in advance of departure, a full refund will be made, less a 4% fee on any monies paid by credit card.

For cancellations inside 120 days, the following penalties will be incurred:

120-90 days before departure - Deposit Amounts

Inside 90 days before departure - 100% of total tour fare becomes non-refundable

**Cancellation penalties and deposit policies follow all partner requirements, policies and penalties.

Trip Insurance

John Hall's Alaska partners with Travel Insured to supply guests with trip insurance. Guests should purchase this prior to making final payment. Details and pricing will be included with initial invoices, final payment reminders and can be found by visiting www.KissAlaska.com. We highly recommend travel insurance for all guests.

**If you intend to take out trip insurance to cancel for any reason, this must be done immediately upon securing your reservation.

Suggested Packing

The dress code is 100% casual while visiting the Southern African region. Clubhouse attire is requested for the Bushtracks Vintage Train dinner. Guests can expect temperatures to range from 50-90 degrees depending on location and weather. Lightweight clothing is best for packing. Remember layers for cool mornings and evenings while traveling onboard safari vehicles.

Our recommendation to pack includes, but is not limited to: rain jacket and umbrella, sunglasses with UV lenses, good shoes for walking on a variety of terrains/surfaces (heavy boots are not required), swimsuit, sunscreen, other sun protection such as hat, shorts, casual sandals and other sun attire.

Dietary Restrictions

Salt free, kosher, food allergies, gluten free or any other special dietary meals must be requested in advance. Please advise this at the time of booking. Due to some remote locations among the World Adventure experience, John Hall's Alaska MUST know any health accommodation requests in advance.

**Please make our reservation team aware of any other accommodations we can assist with during the booking process.

Tour Documents

Tour documents, including detailed itinerary, luggage tags and passenger list will be mailed approximately 14-21 days prior. This may be delayed if payment is not received on time.

Extended Stays and Additional Overnights

Should you wish to spend more time exploring Cape Town or Johannesburg, South Africa by arriving early or extending your trip, John Hall's Alaska will assist in making these arrangements.

Itinerary Revisions

John Hall's Alaska reserves the right to revise the services included in the itinerary such as hotel accommodations, attractions or itinerary order. Should this happen, an equal or greater valued experience will replace that included in the itinerary.

Passports

All guests are required to have a passport valid for 6 months post returning home. Please be prepared to supply John Hall's Alaska with your picture page of your passport at the time of booking.
