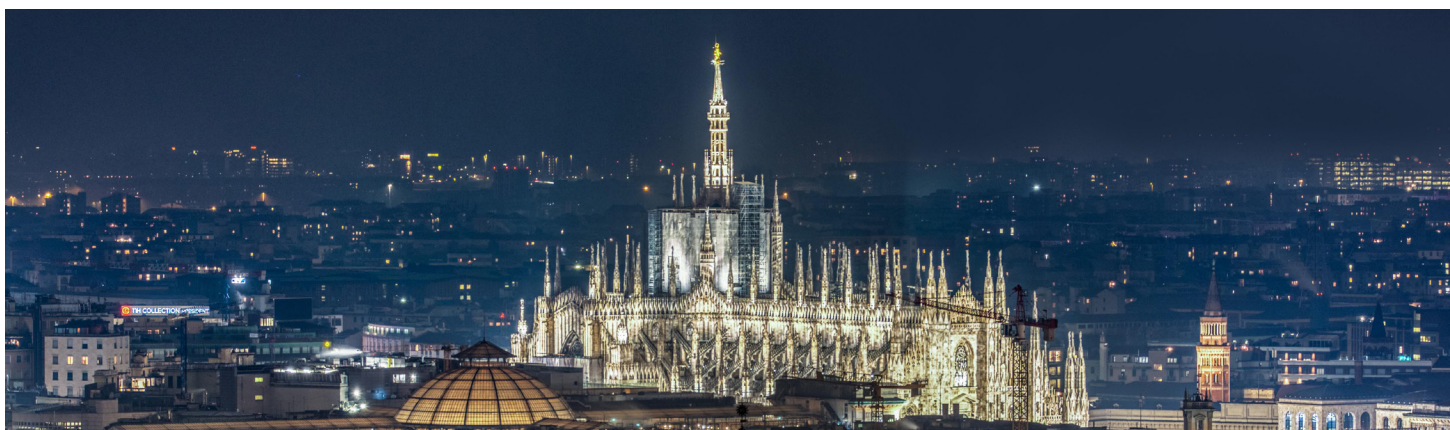
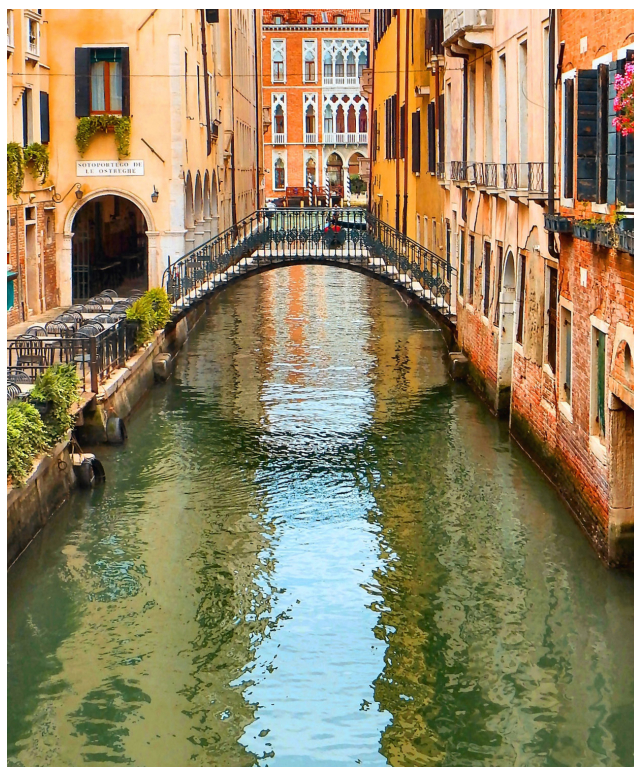

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1 WELCOME TO ITALY

Welcome to Italy – or as the locals say “Benvenuti in Italia!” Upon arrival in Milan, guests will be met by a John Hall’s Alaska World Adventure representative and transferred to the home for the next two evenings, the Radisson Touring Hotel located in the heart of Milan. Take in the afternoon at your leisure before a welcome dinner with fellow traveling companions. Immerse in the Italian food, wine and extravagant culinary scene.

2 MILAN HIGHLIGHTS AND ART

After a welcome breakfast, this morning includes a visit to view Leonardo de Vinci’s “The Last Supper.” Enjoy a local guide sharing the 15th-century masterpiece and pivotal work of the High Renaissance. Following lunch, visit Milan’s Duomo, taking in the rooftop terrace and spanning views showcasing the construction, stonework and Renaissance era treasures. End the day with the culinary traditions of Milan and dinner.

3 FRANCIACORTA WINE REGION

Depart Milan for the first venture into Italy’s wine region, known for the sparkling wine production using a traditional method. Over lunch, enjoy a wine tasting experience with a historical narrative of the important viticulture heritage of the region. Following lunch, visit Iseo, a historical Medieval planned city including Saint Andrew’s Church. Check into the L’Albereta Resort tucked in Italy’s Franciacorta region filled with luxury at every turn.

4 VENICE BY BOAT

Following breakfast, depart for Venice. While the bustle of Venice is often a highlight, travel by private boat directly to the accommodations for the next two evenings, Palazzo Priuli, located on the quiet island of Venice. This is a perfect showcase of the city known to be built on water. Following lunch, visit Saint Mark’s Square. Spend the remainder of the evening at leisure taking in the beautiful hotel, city and location.

5 VENICE HIGHLIGHTS

After a short walk to the ferry terminal, or Zattere, a day of exploring Venice highlights awaits. This includes visiting the “hidden gems of Venice” – Sestieri, Dorsoduro, Santa Croce and San Polo – all districts within Venice. While all are incredibly different, all provide a valuable background to the history and fight of Venice through the Roman Empire of the 5th and 6th centuries to as recently as the 20th century. Explore on your own this afternoon while enjoying time at leisure.

6 ISLANDS OF VENICE

Transfer by boat today to a variety of locations around Venice. Start with Burano known for its history in lace-making, colorful houses and a significant fishing history. Continue to Murano for a glass blowing demonstration showcasing the significant centuries-old tradition and fine craftsmanship. This evening, check into accommodations on the island of Murano before enjoying dinner and a new perspective of the waters surrounding Venice.

7 RAVENNA AND PERUGIA

Enjoy the last glimpse of Venice as guests board a private vessel to Tronchetto, waving goodbye to the beautiful city. Continue the journey via motorcoach to Perugia, the capital of Umbria, marking the transition from the coastal city to the historical heartland of central Italy. Stop in Ravenna, a city nestled within the heart of the Italy’s famous food region of Emilia-Romagna, which includes eight UNESCO designated World Heritage Sites. Continue to Perugia, one of the earliest and most influential cities, cultures and historical locations in pre-Roman Italy. Settle into the accommodations for the next three evenings, the boutique Locanda Della Posta, located in the heart of Perugia just steps from history.

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8 MEDIEVAL HERITAGE OF PERUGIA

Start the morning by experiencing Perugia with a guided tour visiting the historical center of town. Continue to the Abbey of St. Peter, including the genetics of Perugia history. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure while experiencing the hotels offerings, location and culinary delights.

9 EXPERIENCE UMBRIA'S CULTURE

Italy is known for far more than just its wine and pasta. Today, experience another delight of the culinary scene. The day begins with an olive oil tour and tasting experience. Visit one of the leading local producers learning firsthand Umbria's and Italy's agriculture traditions. This afternoon, visit Assisi, the birthplace of St. Francis, before returning to Perugia.

10 ORVIETO AND ROME

Depart Perugia and venture towards one of Italy's most well known cities - Rome. Recognized for the history, Rome is certainly a fabulous finish to the Italian experience. En route to Rome, stop in Orvieto for a guided tour of the Orvieto Cathedral, featuring gothic architecture and a fantastic feat of engineering. Continue to Rome, the former capital of the Roman Empire, and arrive at the Monti Palace Hotel, home for three evenings. Experience a rooftop dinner waiting upon arrival.

11 ANCIENT ROME

Experience ancient Rome through a guided tour, starting with the highlights of the city. Visits include the Flavia Amphitheatre, more commonly referred to as the Colosseum. Feel the history while experiencing one of Rome's most emblematic symbols of history. Visit the Arch of Constantine, Roman Forum and the political center of Rome including Palatine Hill. Experience a Roman lunch before continuing the walking tour and returning to the hotel for the remainder of the afternoon at leisure.

12 ROME HIGHLIGHTS

Start the day with the Vatican Museums and a view of the Sistine Chapel. After passing through the Vatican walls, continue to one of the most fascinating museums in the world. Finish with the Sistine Chapel, which was entirely created by the masterful hands of Michelangelo. A farewell dinner awaits while reminiscing about the Italian experience covered through the past twelve days.

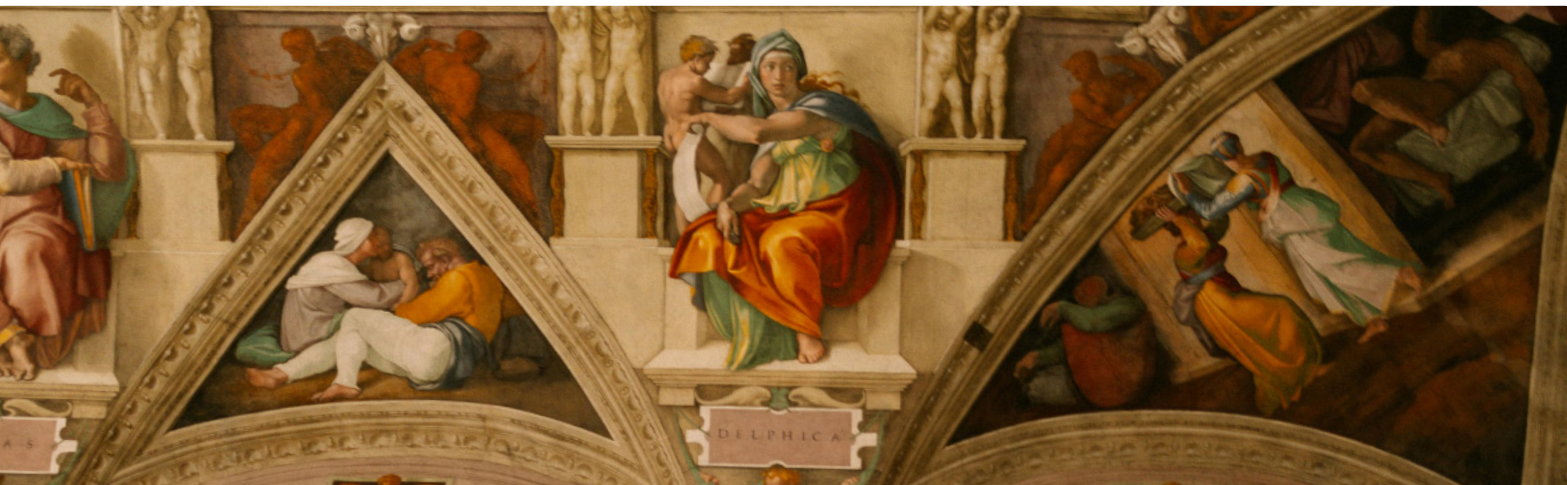

All John Hall's Alaska World Adventures are fully-guided by individuals who understand and are experts in the field, history and regions visited. While in Italy, John Hall's Alaska will partner with local expert drivers and guides in each location to provide transportation and extensive knowledge of the culture and natural surroundings. A John Hall's Alaska representative will accompany the full tour to ensure standards are met throughout the program.

Dining Style

All meals are included while traveling with John Hall's Alaska World Adventures throughout Italy. When possible, programs support locally sourced businesses with the ability to provide the most authentic experience. A variety of options will be available for guests during their dining experiences. **Please let us know at the time of booking if there are any food allergies or intolerances.**

Beverages

Complimentary beverages will be provided at breakfast, lunch and dinner including water, coffee, iced tea, soft drinks and lemonade. During lunch and dinner service, a choice of alcoholic beverage will also be offered. Premium beverages, bottles of wine or other high end alcoholic drinks may be an additional charge.

****Lunch beverage service is based on local restrictions and may be limited to beer/wine service only.**

Wireless Internet and Electrical Outlets

All included hotels provide free wireless internet, although some only provide access in the hotel lobby. Electrical outlets throughout Italy includes 230 volt supply. A voltage converter will be necessary.

Baggage Handling, Tax and Gratuities

Don't lift a finger! We take care of all luggage, delivering it to the guests' room each evening and picking it up for departure. All entrance fees, hotel charges, taxes, fees and resort fees are included. In addition, gratuities for activities, meals, baggage handling, local Italy guides and drivers are also included.

****Gratuities for John Hall's Alaska representatives are not included with the tour package and are at guests' discretion. \$7-10 per person, per day is recommended.**

Luggage Restrictions

One piece of luggage per guest will be delivered to your room while traveling between hotels. Airline requirements allow one suitcase under 50 pounds. Carry-on luggage should be manageable and fit in the overhead storage compartments of motorcoaches.

****Rollaboard carry on luggage will not be permitted in the motorcoach overhead space.**

International Travel

A visa is currently not required for US or Canadian citizens to travel to Italy. Starting in 2026, all visitors staying for under 90 days in length will be required to obtain authorization to travel through the European Travel Information Authorization System (ETIAS.) While this is not considered a traditional travel visa, it provides authorization for visa-exempt individuals such as US Citizens. John Hall's Alaska will assist in applying for any necessary travel verification while visiting Italy.

It is important to note a valid passport book will be required for international travel to Italy and must be valid for at least 6 months past the tour completion date.



IMPORTANT DETAILS

How to Book

To confirm your reservation, a deposit of **\$3500.00 USD per person** is due within 10 days of reservation. To reserve your space, please contact John Hall's Alaska at 800.325.2270. Guests may also book online by visiting our World Adventure page at www.KissAlaska.com. Deposits are accepted by check or credit card including Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express.

****A discount of \$300 USD per person will be extended for those paying their tour balance by cash or check. Deposit may still be made by credit card, however will be subject to a 4% fee if cancelled outside 120 days.**

Final Payment

Final payment is due **120** days prior to departure date. If payment is not received in time, space may be released. Additional monies are not due between deposit and final payment. Guests will be charged a \$35 USD per check that is submitted with insufficient funds.

Tour Cancellation

If a cancellation is made in writing at least 121 days in advance of departure, a full refund will be made, less a 4% fee on any monies paid by credit card.

For cancellations inside 120 days, the following penalties will be incurred:

Inside 120 days before departure - 100% of total tour fare becomes non-refundable

****Cancellation penalties and deposit policies follow all partner requirements, policies and penalties.**

Trip Insurance

John Hall's Alaska partners with Travel Insured to supply guests with trip insurance. Guests should purchase this prior to making final payment. Details and pricing will be included with initial invoices and final payment reminders and can be found by visiting www.KissAlaska.com. We highly recommend travel insurance for all guests.

****If you intend to take out trip insurance to cancel for any reason, this must be done immediately upon securing your reservation.**

Suggested Packing

The dress code is 100% casual while traveling throughout Italy. Comfortable walking shoes are a must (closed-toed shoes with good traction) for days spent touring, waterproof shoes are recommended. A lightweight rain jacket, poncho or umbrella are recommended, along with sunscreen, insect repellent and a hat with visor for rain and sun protection. Temperatures range from the mid-50s in higher elevations to the low 70s during October. Northern and coastal regions may be slightly cooler, especially during the evenings. Lightweight clothing that can be easily layered is best.

It is important to remember the European culture, including Italy, dresses slightly more formal for evenings. Many restaurants will request guests refrain from wearing jeans and shorts while visiting the dining rooms. Casual wear, such as gym wear, is avoided at all times throughout the country.

Dietary Restrictions

Salt free, kosher, food allergies, gluten free or any other special dietary meals must be requested in advance. Please advise this at the time of booking.

****Please make our reservation team aware of any other accommodations we can assist with during the booking process.**

Tour Documents

Tour documents, including detailed itinerary, luggage tags and passenger list will be mailed approximately 14-21 days prior. This may be delayed if payment is not received on time.

Extended Stays and Additional Overnights

Should you wish to spend more time exploring Milan or Rome by arriving early or extending your trip, John Hall's Alaska will assist in making these arrangements. We highly recommend all guests consider arriving into Milan a day early to avoid missing portions of the tour due to flight delays. This also assists with any jet lag possibilities.
