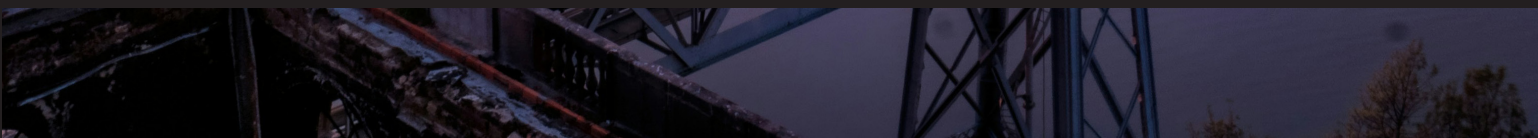

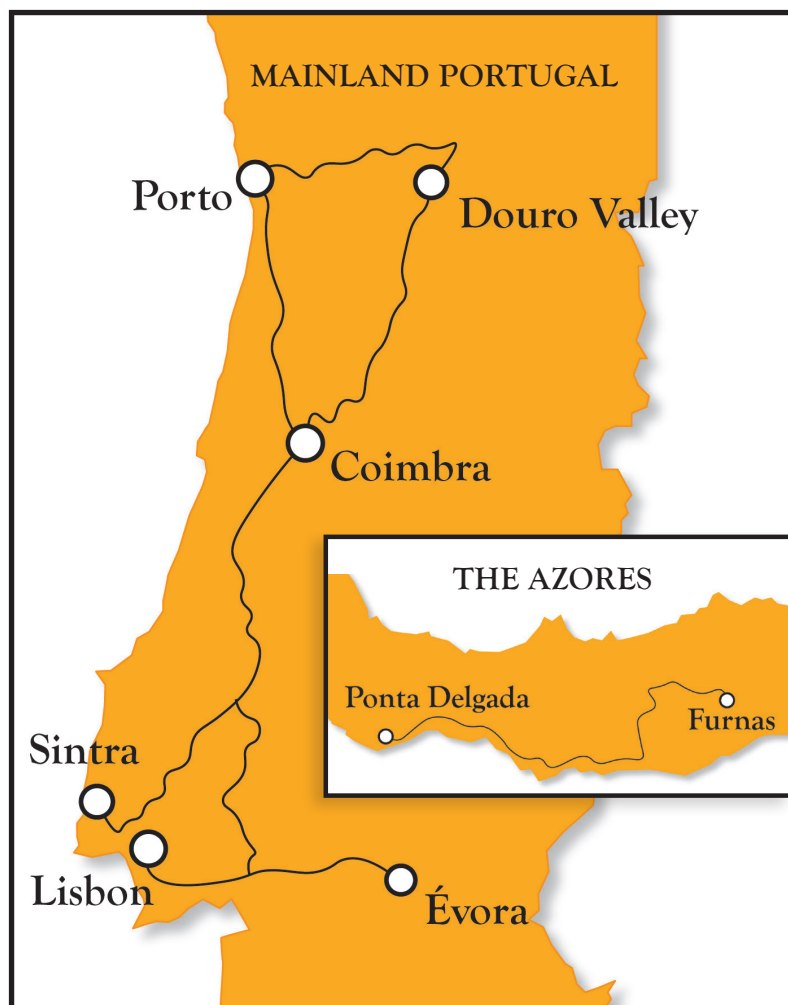

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1 SÃO MIGUEL | ARRIVAL IN THE AZORES

The adventure begins the moment you touch down on São Miguel, the largest island of the Azores. After clearing customs, meet a John Hall's Alaska representative and transfer to the hotel in Ponta Delgada. The remainder of the afternoon includes a relaxed walking introduction to the historic center. See the city's basalt archways, traditional whitewashed buildings and waterfront streets that reflect the island's volcanic heritage and Atlantic setting. This is Portugal, but wilder.

2 SWEET FRUIT AND VOLCANIC LANDSCAPES

Begin the morning with a visit to a traditional pineapple plantation, where fruit is grown in centuries-old greenhouses using techniques as patient and particular as the volcanic soil demands. Continue west to the Sete Cidades region, known for its twin crater lakes and sweeping volcanic scenery. Enjoy time at several viewpoints overlooking the caldera before returning to Ponta Delgada for the evening.

3 TEA FIELDS, ISLAND TOWNS & GEOTHERMAL VALLEYS

Travel across the island to Chá Gorreana, Europe's only tea plantation, where the fields have been producing since the 1880s. Learn how the leaves are processed in the original Victorian machinery and have a cup at the source. Continue to Ribeira Grande for a brief visit and lunch. In the afternoon, arrive in Furnas, a geothermal area known for its hot springs and botanical gardens. Check in and relax in the thermal baths before dinner.

4 NORTHEAST COAST & VOLCANIC COOKING

Head to Nordeste, one of São Miguel's most scenic regions. Viewpoints, coastal cliffs and quiet villages highlight this lessvisited corner of the island. Weather permitting, enjoy a picnic lunch overlooking the Atlantic. Return to Furnas for one of the most extraordinary dining experiences the Azores has to offer: Cozido das Furnas. This traditional meal of meats, sausages and vegetables is slow cooked in the ground using natural geothermal heat.

5 SÃO MIGUEL TO THE MAINLAND

Depart Furnas this morning and transfer to the airport for your flight to Lisbon. Upon arrival, begin exploring Portugal's capital with a walking tour through the historic districts of Alfama and Baixa. These neighborhoods reflect Lisbon's oldest roots, with narrow streets, traditional tiled buildings and local shops that have served the community for generations. This evening, enjoy a Fado dinner. The performance introduces Portugal's traditional musical style, accompanied by a regional meal in an intimate setting.

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6 BELÉM & PORTUGUESE CULINARY TRADITIONS

Spend the morning in the district of Belém, home to several of Portugal's most significant monuments. Visit the Jerónimos Monastery, Tower of Belém and the Monument to the Discoveries, each reflecting in its own way the country's history. This evening, take part in a hands-on Portuguese cooking class featuring regional ingredients and traditional techniques. Enjoy the meal you help prepare.

7 THE ALENTEJO REGION

Depart Lisbon for the Alentejo, a rural region known for cork forests, olive groves and open landscapes. Visit a working cork farm to learn about harvesting and production, followed by lunch and a wine tasting at a local vineyard. Continue to Évora, a walled city where Romans, Moors and medieval kings all left their mark. Visit the Chapel of Bones in the Church of Saint Francis before checking in at your hotel.

8 LIVE LIKE A LOCAL IN ÉVORA

Enjoy a free morning to explore Évora at your own pace. Options include visiting the Roman Temple, browsing local shops or relaxing in the town square at a café table. In the afternoon, participate in a cooking class focused on Alentejo cuisine, known for its hearty dishes and regional ingredients like slow-braised meats, hand-rolled breads and olive oil. Dinner is the feast you've created.

9 TOMAR & COIMBRA

Travel north to Tomar for a guided visit of the Convento de Cristo, a historic complex linked to the Knights Templar and their lasting influence on Portuguese history. After lunch, continue to Coimbra, home to one of the oldest universities in the western world. Explore the historic center and learn about the city's academic traditions.

10 THE DOURO VALLEY

Drive into the Douro Valley, one of the world's oldest wineproducing regions and the birthplace of Port wine. Visit a celebrated estate for a wine tasting and lunch overlooking the valley. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic river cruise along the Douro, offering views of the landscape of terraced vineyards, painstakingly carved into near-vertical schist hillsides over two thousand years.

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11 TILES & TRADITION IN PORTO

Travel west toward Porto, a deeply lovable city of bridges, azulejos and riverfront tascas. Before exploring, take part in a tilepainting workshop to learn about the tradition of Portuguese azulejos, hand-painted ceramic tile ubiquitous to the country. Enjoy lunch afterward. The remainder of the afternoon is free to explore Porto at your own pace. Follow your instincts down to the Ribeira, lose yourself in the backstreets of the Bonfim or simply find a café terrace and relax.

12 DISCOVERING PORTO & PORT WINE TASTING

Begin the day with a guided walking tour of Porto, including the Sé Cathedral, Clérigos Tower and the Dom Luís I Bridge. Enjoy lunch along the Ribeira, Porto's waterfront and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In the afternoon, cross the river to Vila Nova de Gaia for a Port wine lodge tour and tasting.

13 COASTAL TOWNS & MEDIEVAL VILLAGES

Travel south along the dramatic Atlantic coast to Nazaré, known for its fishing traditions and dramatic shoreline. Continue to Óbidos, a walled medieval village with narrow streets and wellpreserved architecture and traditions. Arrive in Sintra later in the day and check in at your hotel. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers.

14 SINTRA'S PALACES & GARDENS

Spend the day exploring Sintra, beginning with a guided visit to Quinta da Regaleira, a 19th-century estate known for its gardens, tunnels and architectural features like hidden grottos and initiation wells. Continue to the Palácio Nacional de Sintra, the former residence of Portuguese royalty.

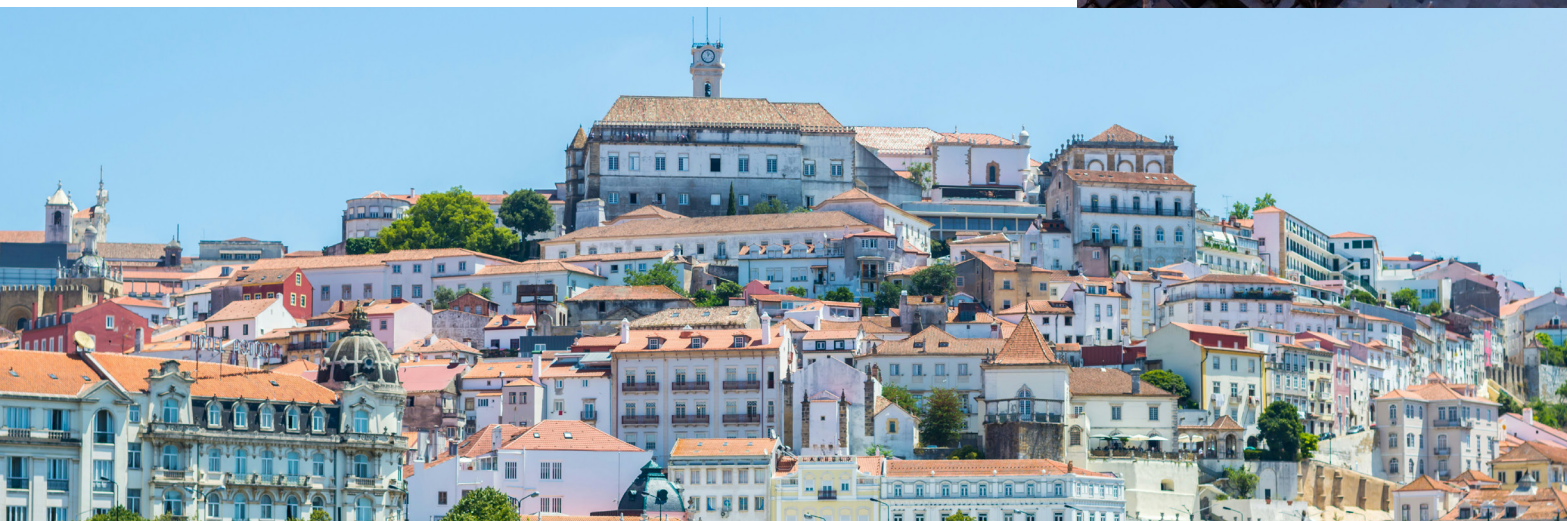
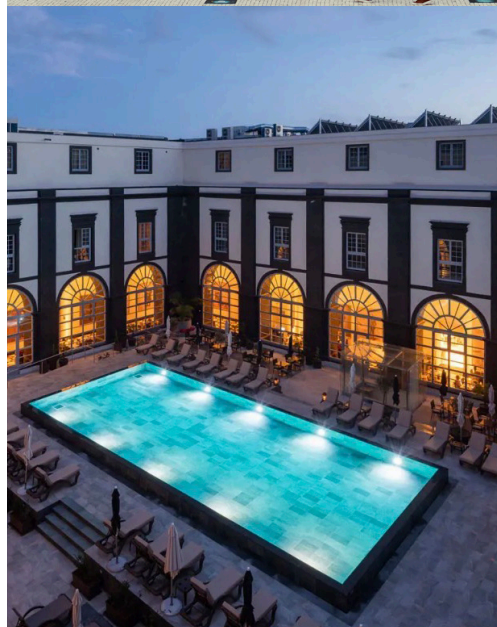

THE PORTUGAL EXPERIENCE

Expert Drivers and Guides

All packages are fully-guided by individuals who understand and are experts in the field, history and regions visited. While in both the Azores and mainland Portugal, John Hall's Alaska will pair with expert drivers and guides in each location. All individuals act with extensive knowledge which will share information during the World Adventure. All tours also include a John Hall's Alaska representative to ensure all John Hall's Alaska standards are met throughout the program.

Cell Phones and Wi-Fi

Wireless internet is available for complimentary use or a minimal charge, dependent on the overnight accommodation property. Cell phones coverage may be limited, however most major carriers offer international coverage in both locations for a fee.

Dining Style

All meals are included while traveling with John Hall's Alaska World Adventures to Portugal. When possible, programs support locally sourced businesses with the ability to provide the most authentic experience. This includes a variety of local fruits, vegetables, fish, and other proteins unique to the Azores and mainland. A variety of options will be available for guests during their dining experiences. **Please let us know at the time of booking if there are any food allergies or intolerances.**

Beverages

Complimentary beverages will be provided at breakfast, lunch and dinner including unlimited water, coffee, iced tea, soft drinks and lemonade. During dinner meal service, a choice of alcoholic beverage will also be offered.

Electricity During your Travels

Outlets for use in Portugal (including the Azores) are the Europlug CEE 7/16 or Type C and the Standard European Schuko CEE 7/4 or Type F (interchangeable; Type F is "grounded" for higher powered electronics). Make sure you have the correct adapter and that your appliances are dual voltage.

Baggage Handling, Tax and Gratuities

Don't lift a finger! John Hall's Alaska takes care of all luggage, delivering it to the guests' room each evening and picking it up for departure. All entrance fees, hotel charges, taxes, fees and resort fees are included. In addition, gratuities for activities, meals, baggage handling, local guides and drivers are also included.

****Gratuities for John Hall's Alaska representatives are not included with the tour package and are at guests' discretion. \$7-10 per person, per day is recommended.**

Luggage Handling

All gratuities for luggage handling are included with your John Hall's Alaska package. One piece of luggage per guest will be delivered to your room at each property while traveling in the Azores and Portugal. Local airline requirements allow one suitcase under 50 pounds. Carry-on luggage should be manageable and fit in the overhead of storage compartments on airplanes and motorcoaches, keeping in mind several of these are smaller than your traditional airline overheads. Carry on luggage should not exceed 18 inches for its largest dimension.

Group Flights

All flights for traveling between the Azores and Portugal are included as part of the package.

International Visas & Requirements

The John Hall's World Adventure program includes application fees and work, so you do not have to worry about a thing!

Passports

All guests are required to have a passport valid for 6 months post returning home. Please be prepared to supply John Hall's Alaska with your picture page of your passport at the time of booking.

Tour Documents

Tour documents, including detailed itinerary, luggage tags and passenger list will be mailed approximately 14-21 days prior. This may be delayed if payment is not received on time.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

How to Book

To confirm your reservation, a deposit of \$3500.00 USD per person is due within 10 days of reservation. To reserve your space, please contact our office at 800.325.2270. Guests may also book online by visiting our World Adventure page at www.World.KissAlaska.com. Deposits are accepted by check or credit card including Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express.

****A discount of \$300 USD per person will be extended for those paying their tour balance by cash or check. Deposit may still be made by credit card, however will be subject to a 4% fee if cancelled outside 120 days.**

Tour Payment

Due to increased deposits, the tour has applicable requested payments refundable up until 120 days prior to departure. A secondary payment of 25% is due February 1, 2027.

Final Payment

Final payment is due 120 days prior to departure date. If payment is not received in time, space may be released. Additional monies are not due between deposit and final payment. Guests will be charged \$35 USD per check that is submitted with insufficient funds.

Tour Cancellation

If a cancellation is made in writing at least 120 days in advance of departure, a full refund will be made, minus a 4% fee on any monies paid by credit card.

For cancellations inside 120 days, the following penalties will be incurred:

Inside 120 days before departure - 100% of total tour fare becomes non-refundable

****Cancellation penalties and deposit policies follow all partner requirements, policies and penalties.**

Trip Insurance

John Hall's Alaska partners with Travel Insured to supply guests with trip insurance. Guests should purchase this prior to making final payment. Details and pricing will be included with initial invoices, final payment reminders and can be found by visiting www.KissAlaska.com. We highly recommend travel insurance for all guests.

****If you intend to take out trip insurance to cancel for any reason, this must be done immediately upon securing your reservation.**

Suggested Packing

During the tour, daytime attire is 100% casual. Guests should feel comfortable wearing shorts, jeans, t-shirts and other relaxed clothing while exploring the Azores and mainland Portugal. For evening meals, most restaurants expect clubhouse attire - this generally means limiting very casual items such as shorts and jeans. Any additional formal evening requirements will be noted in your final itinerary.

Both the Azores and mainland Portugal have mild climates. Guests can expect temperatures to range from 50-70 degrees depending on the locations, activities and elevation. Clothing that can be easily layered is best to pack. Our recommendation to pack includes, but is not limited to: rain jacket and umbrella, shorts, long pants, t-shirt, light sweater, sunglasses and other sun protection such as a hat. It is recommended to bring smart casual attire for dinners including slacks, golf polos or casual dresses/skirt.

Dietary Restrictions

Salt free, kosher, food allergies, gluten free or any other special dietary meals must be requested in advance. Please advise this at the time of booking. **Due to some remote locations among the World Adventure experience, John Hall's Alaska MUST know any health accommodation requests in advance.**

****Please make our reservation team aware of any other accommodations we can assist with during the booking process.**
