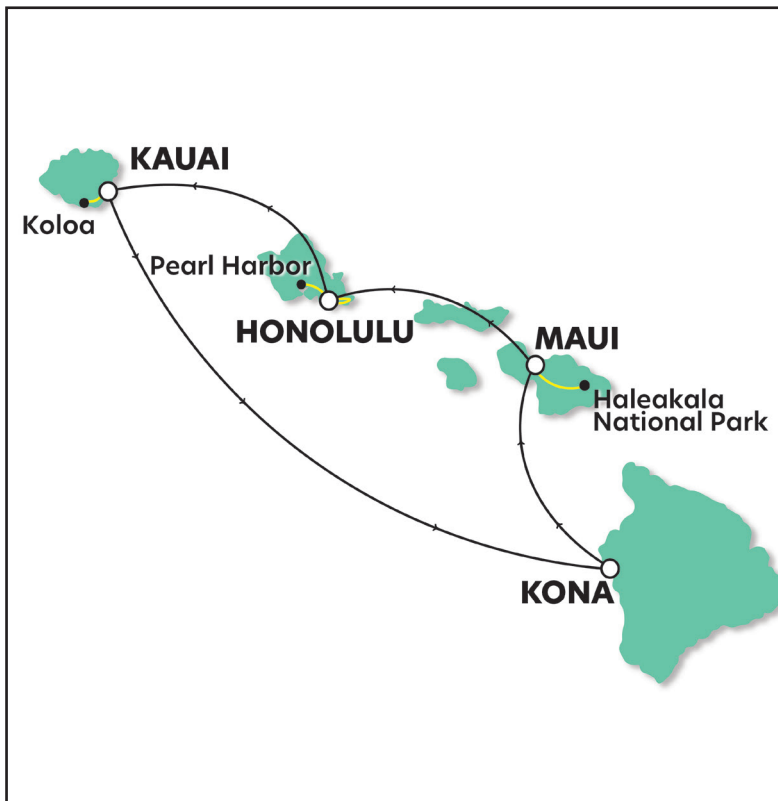

1 ALOHA TO HONOLULU

The first experience of "Aloha" begins upon arrival at the Honolulu International Airport and being presented with the traditional flower lei. Then transfer to the Hyatt Regency Resort & Spa located in the heart of Waikiki. The island of Oahu is called the "Gathering Place," so while other travelers arrive this evening, dinner is at leisure in any of the hotel's restaurants. Relax and enjoy the surroundings!

2 AMERICA IN WWII

Today is all about remembering WWII heroes with a day at Pearl Harbor.

The first stop will be visiting the USS Arizona Memorial, which marks the resting place of 1,102 of the 1,177 soldiers and sailors killed on the ship during the 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor. From the reason for the United States' entry into WWII to its conclusion - with lunch in between - the day ends with a docent guided walking tour of the USS Battleship Missouri. Stand on the surrender deck where General MacArthur signed the treaty in Tokyo Bay to end WWII on the ship that's now docked at Pearl Harbor. Return to the hotel to freshen up before dinner.

Visitors come a long way to be in Hawaii. Choose how to spend this day with an included activity. 4 EAST SHORE & IOLANI PALACE

Touring the eastern shores of Oahu reveals pristine sites that make people fall in love with Hawaii. Lush tropical rain forests, rocky cliffs and incredible views of the blue Pacific Ocean define the Windward side. Enjoy lunch and continue with a full city tour of Honolulu including the National Cemetery of the Pacific (Punchbowl), the Governor's Mansion, the state capitol building, Chinatown and the King Kamehameha statue. The last stop of the day is a tour of the Iolani Palace. The only royal palace on American soil, this was the official residence of Hawaii's former monarchy.

5 KAUAI

Fly to the garden isle of Kauai. Upon arrival, experience the unexpected agriculture of Kauai visiting Kilohana Plantation. The experience includes a farm tour followed by a Mai Tai demonstration, illustrating the importance of Sugar Cane history to Hawaii. Conclude with dinner before checking into the newest property on Hawaii, the Hale Hokuale Kauai.

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6 CIRCLE KAUAI

Today, visit Waimea Canyon – nicknamed “The Grand Canyon of the Pacific” by Mark Twain. Along the way, learn about the history of the area through a visual and verbal tour of places such as Old Koloa Town, circa 1834, heart of Hawaii’s first sugar cane plantation, and Waimea, the little town that grew up where Captain Cook first set foot in Hawaii in 1778. Upon arriving at the 3,400-foot canyon overlook, experience an unsurpassed 360-degree panoramic view of this geological wonder. After lunch, head to Hanalei, most well-known for the beaches and mountains pictured in so many movies.

7 THE BIG ISLAND

Expert Drivers and Guides

All packages are fully-guided by John Hall's Alaska representatives combined with local narration from Hawaiian residents who understand and are experts in the field, history and regions visited. While in Hawaii, John Hall's Alaska will pair with expert drivers and guides in each location. All individuals act with extensive knowledge which will share information during the World Adventure. All tours also include a John Hall's Alaska representative to ensure all John Hall's Alaska standards are met throughout the program.

Dining Style

While John Hall's Alaska packages traditionally include all meals with packages, most meals are included for the Hawaiian Island adventure. During "Pick Your Adventure Days", guests will have breakfast only included, allowing for flexibility to experience local flare of the islands at leisure. When possible, programs support locally sourced businesses with the ability to provide the most authentic experience. This includes a variety of local fruits, vegetables, fish, and other proteins unique to the Hawaii islands. A variety of options will be available for guests during their dining experiences. **Please let us know at the time of booking if there are any food allergies or intolerances.**

Beverages

Complimentary beverages will be provided at breakfast, lunch and dinner including unlimited water, coffee, iced tea, soft drinks and lemonade. Where available, beer and wine is also included with lunch. During dinner meal service, non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages will be included.

Baggage Handling, Tax and Gratuities

Don't lift a finger! John Hall's Alaska takes care of all luggage, delivering it to the guests' room each evening and picking it up for departure. All entrance fees, hotel charges, taxes, fees and resort fees are included. In addition, gratuities for activities, meals, baggage handling, local guides and drivers are also included.

****Gratuities for John Hall's Alaska representatives are not included with the tour package and are at guests' discretion. \$7-10 per person, per day is recommended.**

Group Flights

All flights for traveling between the Hawaiian Islands are included as part of the package and includes service in comfort service.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

How to Book

To confirm your reservation, a deposit of \$3500 per person is due within 10 days of reservation. To reserve your space, please contact the John Hall's Alaska office at 800.325.2270. Guests may also book online by visiting our World Adventure page at www.KissAlaska.com. Deposits are accepted by check or credit card including Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express.

****A discount of \$300 USD per person will be extended for those paying their tour balance by cash or check. Deposit may still be made by credit card, however will be subject to a 4% fee if cancelled outside 120 days.**

Final Payment

Final payment is due 120 days prior to departure date. If payment is not received in time, space may be released. Additional monies are not due between deposit and final payment. Guests will be charged a \$35 USD per check that is submitted with insufficient funds.

Tour Cancellation

If a cancellation is made in writing at least 120 days in advance of departure, a full refund will be made, less a 4% fee on any monies paid by credit card.

For cancellations inside 120 days, the following penalties will be incurred:

60 - 120 days before departure - 50% of total tour fare becomes non-refundable

Inside 60 days before departure - 100% of total tour fare becomes non-refundable

****Cancellation penalties and deposit policies follow all partner requirements, policies and penalties.**

Trip Insurance

John Hall's Alaska partners with Travel Insured to supply guests with trip insurance. Guests should purchase this prior to making final payment. ****If you intend to take out trip insurance to cancel for any reason, this must be done immediately upon securing your reservation.**

Suggested Packing

The dress code is 100% casual in Hawaii! You can expect temperatures to range from 70-85 degrees depending on the island, activities and elevation. On Mountain ascents, it can reach colder temperatures of 30-50 degrees. Lightweight clothing that can be easily layered is the way to go. Each hotel will provide beach towels and bottles for pool use. Bottled water will be available on the motorcoach during touring days only.

Our recommendation includes, but not limited to: Shorts, capri pants, golf polos, t-shirts, lightweight jacket, bathing suits, sunglasses, sun protection, sandals, beach cover up, beach bag and closed-toed shoes

Dietary Restrictions

Salt free, kosher, food allergies, gluten free or any other special dietary meals must be requested in advance. Please advise this at the time of booking.

****Please make the reservation team aware of any other accommodations we can provide for during the booking process. Due to Hawaii's remote nature, many of these require advanced notice for accommodations to be made.**

Cell Phones and Wi-Fi

Wireless internet is available for complimentary use at all properties, dependent on the overnight accommodation property. Cell phones coverage may be limited, however most major carriers offer international coverage in both locations for a fee.

Tour Documents

Tour documents, including detailed itinerary, luggage tags and passenger list will be mailed approximately 14-21 days prior. This may be delayed if payment is not received on time.

Itinerary Revisions

John Hall's Alaska reserves the right to revise the services included in the itinerary such as hotel accommodations, attractions or itinerary order. Should this happen, an equal or greater value experience will replace that included in the itinerary.

Drivers License/Passports

All guests are required to have a valid government issued identification. Air travel to the Hawaiian Islands as well as inter-island travel requires a REAL ID or passport.
